

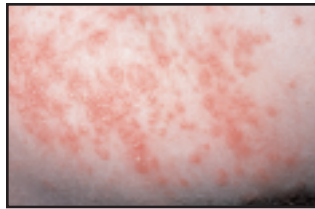

What causes fungal infections?

Fungal infections are caused by microscopic organisms (fungi) that can live on the dead tissues of the hair, nails and outer skin layers. It may involve almost any skin surface on the body, but usually occurs in warm, moist, creased areas (such as armpits and groins).

Fungal infections include mold-like fungi that cause: athlete's foot, jock itch, ringworm, *Tinea capitis*

Fungal infections also include yeast-like fungi (such as *Candida*). *Candida* yeast infections include: diaper rash, cutaneous candidiasis and some cases of genital rashes

Symptoms

- Itching (may be intense)
- Skin lesion or rash
- Skin redness or inflammation
- Enlarging patch
- Macule or papule
- Located on the skin folds, genitals, trunk, buttocks, under the breasts or other skin areas
- Infection of hair follicles ("folliculitis") may have a pimple-like appearance

Treatment

General hygiene is vital to the treatment of cutaneous fungal infections; keeping the skin dry and exposed to air is helpful. Apply Inzo Antifungal to treat fungal infections, over dry skin, mainly after showering.
