The SADMERC and the three Program Safeguard Contractors (PSCs) have completed the HCPCS Coding Verification Review on October 27, 2006 for the above listed product(s) manufactured and/or distributed by your company. This review resulted in a consensus coding decision.

It is our determination that the above listed product(s) meet(s) the description for a HCPCS code as defined in the PSC Medical Policy for Surgical Dressings. Therefore, the correct Medicare billing code(s) for the product(s) is/are:

A6203 Composite dressing, pad size 16 sq. in. or less, with any size adhesive border, each dressing.

This HCPCS coding decision applies to the submitted product(s) as presented to and reviewed by the SADMERC and three PSCs.
